



Tree House All-Knowing Parent Guide

Memory Verse: "Long ago at many times and in many ways, God spoke to our fathers by the prophets..."
Hebrews 1:1 NLT

Week 1

Your child learned that God gave Isaiah a special dream to peek into heaven and see how holy God is. God then gave Isaiah a message to take to His people. The message was that God knows everything including our sin and His people needed to turn and follow Him.

Read: Isaiah 6:1-8

Activity: Read the passage out loud with your child. Have them draw a picture of the scene described in the passage. Talk with your child about how holy and mighty God is and that He wants us to follow Him.

Week 2

Your child learned that God told Elijah what to say and do to show the people that He is the one true God and that they should only worship Him. Elijah obeyed God and did what he asked. God knows everything and we need to follow Him.

Read: 1 Kings 18:30-39

Activity: Go outside and have your child collect 12 rocks. As you read the story have them pretend to build an altar like Elijah's. Pour water on top of the altar three times. Talk about how God is all-knowing and allowed Elijah's altar to catch on fire even though he poured water on it. Discuss how we should follow God just like Elijah did.

Week 3

Your child learned that God allowed Daniel to interpret the King's dream. Daniel told the King that God would take his kingdom if he continued to brag. The King didn't listen and God did what he said he would do.

Read: Daniel 2

Activity: Brainstorm with your child their talents and things they are good at (being kind, thoughtful, generous, etc.). Discuss how those gifts are given to us by the Lord. Stop and pray to thank God for creating us and giving us our talents.

Week 4

Your child learned that God sent a message to His people through Isaiah. The message told of how God would send His son Jesus to be our Shepherd and a light in our dark world.

Activity: Turn out the lights in the room. Stand across the room and have your child try to find you. Then hand them a flashlight and have them try to find you again. Talk about how Jesus is the light that is guiding us through life.
